### Belmont Bruins at Lipscomb Bisons

February 12, 2009

Allen Arena – Nashville, Tenn.

In a week of rivalry games ranging from Duke-North Carolina, Missouri-Kansas, West Virginia-Pittsburgh and Georgetown-Syracuse, the CSS Atlantic Sun Game of the Week turns its attention to the league's longest-standing rivalry. Thursday night's Belmont-Lipscomb showdown marks the 124th edition of the Battle of the Boulevard. Belmont won the first meeting, a 79-74 on its home court last month. Lipscomb has won three of the last four meetings held in Allen Arena. Belmont's lone victory during that span came last year with the Bruins held on for a 99-91 victory in double overtime.

Tonight's meeting marks the 124<sup>th</sup> edition of the Battle of the Boulevard, the most-played series between two current A-Sun institutions.
