The CSS Atlantic Sun Game of the Week features the conference's hottest teams as Lipscomb, winners of four straight, travels to Macon to battle with Mercer, owners of a five-game streak. The Bears have kept the streak alive with a pair of late comebacks. On Feb. 7th, the Bears rallied from at 10-point deficit against Jacksonville to win at the buzzer. On Monday, Mercer overcame shooting 34 percent from the floor to win at Stetson. Lipscomb improved its standing with four straight victories highlighted by a win in the Battle of the Boulevard against Belmont and ending a seven-game losing skid to ETSU. In a guard-heavy league, the spotlight will be on the paint as two of the conference's top inside presences face each other in Adnan Hodzic for the Bisons and Daniel Emerson for the Bears. Hodzic leads the league in FG percentage while Emerson leads in rebounding and in double-doubles. The game can also be seen on ASun.TV.

## A-Sun Player of the Week: Adnan Hodzic, Lipscomb

Facing a three-game in five-day gauntlet that featured two of the Atlantic Sun's frontrunners, Lipscomb's Adnan Hodzic pushed the Bisons back to a .500 conference record to earn his second Player of the Week award of the season.

Hodzic, a sophomore center from Sarajevo, Bosnia dominated the low post throughout the week as Lipscomb won consecutive home games against Belmont, USC Upstate, and ETSU. Hodzic averaged 19.3 points on 61.9 percent shooting and 9.7 rebounds. Hodzic scored 28 points and pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds as the Bisons broke a three-game losing streak to Belmont with a 73-68 victory in the A-Sun Game of the Week Thursday evening. He also set a Lipscomb NCAA-era record with 13 made field goals.

Two days later, Hodzic posted 18 points and 12 rebounds as the Bisons cruised to a 77-44 victory over USC Upstate, for his third double-double in a row. Hodzic capped his week by scoring 12 points in 18 minutes of action in Lipscomb's 96-91 victory against ETSU. The win snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Buccaneers.

\* Within the same month that saw Jacksonville become the first A-Sun team in almost 20 years to have three players on the roster with 1,000 points, ETSU is approaching that milestone. Kevin Tiggs (1,018 points) joined Courtney Pigram (1,914 points) at that plateau with Mike Smith closing in with 983 points. Only 16 other teams in the country feature at least three 1,000-point scorers.

\* For the first time in conference history, the A-Sun has welcomed a quartet of players to the 1,500-point club. Stetson's Garfield Blair became the latest to reach the mark, joining Pigram, Campbell's Jonathan Rodriguez and Mercer's James Florence.

\* On Monday against ETSU, Lipscomb guard Josh Slater posted the first 10-assist, zero-turnover game in the Atlantic Sun since UNF's Chris Timberlake dished out 11 assists against Jacksonville on January, 9, 2007.



## BELMONT 16-9, 12-4 A-Sun

\* Belmont improved to 16-9, 12-4 this past week with victories over East Tennessee State and USC Upstate. With their 76-56 victory over the Spartans Feb. 16, the Bruins have won 19 consecutive Atlantic Sun Conference home games.

\* Senior point guard Alex Renfroe continues to lead Belmont. The Hermitage, Tenn. native averaged 20.7 points, 7.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game this past week. Renfroe has a team-high five double-doubles on the year and paces the Atlantic Sun Conference in assists per game. He also ranks among the league leaders in eight statistical categories and is among the nation's leaders in rebounding from the guard position.

\* Feb. 16 against USC Upstate, Belmont's Andy Wicke and Matthew Dotson became the first pair of active teammates in Division-I to make 200 or more career three-point field goals. Wicke has 278, while Dotson has 202. Both also eclipsed 1,000 career points this season.

\* Belmont returns to action Friday night at Kennesaw State.



## CAMPBELL 11-15, 8-9 A-Sun

\* Campbell finished its A-Sun road schedule with a 4-6 mark, doubling the number of league wins away from home from 2007-08, when the Camels went 2-6. The Camels also surpassed their overall wins (10-20) and league victories (5-11) from a year ago.

\* Lorne Merthie celebrated his 19th birthday by scoring a career-high 22 points in Monday's 89-83 win at A-Sun leader Jacksonville. The Camels never trailed, while building a 25-point lead in the first half, then withstood Jacksonville's late run by hitting 17-of-20 from the line in the final period to win their third road game in the last four away from home. He scored 16 points in the opening period. He finished the game 7-of-10 from the field, 3-of-3 from long distance and 5-of-7 from the line.

\* Kyle Vejraska, making his first start since Dec. 29, tied his season-high with 18 points, while grabbing eight rebounds. Chris Reynolds also tied his season-high with 12 points off the bench.

\* Jonathan Rodriguez scored 17 points at Jacksonville Monday and moved into a tie for 6th place with Henry Wilson (1604 points from 1985-89) on the all-time Camel scoring charts. Rodriguez (791) moved past Marro Hawkins of Centenary (787 from 1986-90) into 10th place on the A-Sun career rebounding charts.

\* The Buccaneers struggled last week, dropping two games and falling out of first place in the Atlantic Sun Conference standings. The Bucs lost both games on their Nashville swing, falling to Belmont (76-73) on Feb. 14 and Lipscomb (96-91) on Feb. 16. The team is now one game back of both Belmont and Jacksonville for the top spot in league play.

\* Even in the losses, senior forward Kevin Tiggs (Flint, Mich.) was a bright spot for the Bucs, scoring 25 against Belmont and 26 against Lipscomb. Tiggs also reached a milestone against Lipscomb, as he eclipsed the 1,000-point mark for this career with a putback on a miss with 2:08 left in the first half.

\* Along with Tiggs, junior guard Mike Smith (Vandalia, Mo.) is also nearing 1,000 points for his career, after posting his sixth double-double of the season with 20 points and 11 rebounds in the loss to Lipscomb. Currently, Smith is just 17 points shy of 1,000.

\* The Bucs hope to rebound and make one last run at the regular season title later this week, when they travel to face USC Upstate on Thursday, followed by a trip to Campbell on Monday. Both games are set to tip at 7 p.m. (EST).

\* Adnan Hodzic has scored in double-figures in 21 consecutive games, one shy of the Lipscomb NCAA-era record (Brian Fisk, 22 straight from Dec. 8, 2005 to Feb. 24, 2006).

\* Lipscomb held USC Upstate to 44 points on Saturday. It was the fewest points by a Lipscomb opponent since Lipscomb held Central State to 41 points on Mar. 16, 2000.

\* Guards Josh Slater, Jimmy Oden, and Michael Lusk have combined for 47 assists and a 2.35 assist-to-turnover ratio over the last three games.

\* The Bears are five games above .500 for the first time since the 2004-05 edition of the Bears wrapped up the regular season at 16-11.

\* Mercer's current five-game win streak is the Bears' longest since the 2002-03 A-Sun championship team won 12 consecutive games to close out the regular season.

\* UNF head coach Matt Kilcullen is only four wins away from his 100th victory at UNF.

\* In its six wins this season, UNF is holding opponents to 55.7 points per game.

Kris Thomas added nine points and hit the boards for a career-high 10 rebounds.

\* Blair scored his second consecutive double-double with 24 points and a career-high 16 rebounds but it wasn't enough as lost to Mercer on Monday. It was Senior Night in the Edmunds Center and all three Hatter seniors marked the occasion by scoring in double figures. Tim Lang produced his second double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds while Eric Diaz and Kris Thomas added 12 and 10 points respectively.

\* Monday night Garfield Blair moved up to 7th all-time at Stetson with 1,506 points. The Hatters also tied the team record for 3-point field goals in a season with 210.
