The regular-season CSS Atlantic Sun Game of the Week concludes with what looks like an even matchup between Campbell and Stetson. Both own 13-15 overall records with Camels owning a one-game advantage in conference play, 10-9 to the Hatters' 9-10. A Campbell win would cement Stetson as the No. 7 seed in next month's General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Men's Basketball Championships. Campbell's Jonathan Rodriguez begins the week as one of nine active players in the country (and one of just two juniors) to have accumulated at least 1600 points and 800 rebounds for his careers. He squares off with Garfield Blair, in one of the two weekend matchups between the four A-Sun players in the 1500-point club (ETSU's Courtney Pigram and Mercer's James Florence play on Saturday). The game can also be seen on ASun.TV.

A-Sun Player of the Week:

Eni Cuka, UNF

UNF completed its first season sweep of an Atlantic Sun school and extended its win streak to three led by the play of junior guard Eni Cuka, who earned his first Player of the Week award of the season.

Cuka averaged 24 points in leading the Ospreys to a pair of conference wins last week. He tied his career high, pouring in 27 points against FGCU, and knocking down a career-high five 3-pointers in the win. He duplicated that total with five more 3-pointers against Stetson to give the Ospreys their first season sweep of an Atlantic Sun Conference opponent. Cuka finished the Stetson game with 21 points, scoring all of his points either behind the 3-point line or at the foul line. For the week, Cuka connected on 10-of-19 3-pointers while dishing out three assists and adding three steals to his totals.

Since he joined the UNF lineup, he has led the team in scoring at 13.4 points per game while hitting on close to 40 percent of his 3-point tries (39.4 percent, 41-for-104) and 80 percent from the charity stripe (79.4 percent, 50-for-63).

* Within the same month that saw Jacksonville become the first A-Sun team in almost 20 years to have three players on the roster with 1,000 points, ETSU has joined the Dolphins with a trio of 1,000-point scorers. Mike Smith, 1,028 points, joined Courtney Pigram (1,918 points) and Kevin Tiggs (1,062 points). Prior to this year, the 1990 Centenary Gents and the 2000 Samford Bulldogs have been the only A-Sun teams to feature three 1,000-points scorers on the roster.

* With one week remaining in the regular season, no team has secured their seed in next month's General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Championship. Jacksonville clinches the top seed, the bye into the semifinals and a guaranteed spot in the NIT with two wins. The Dolphins will earn it as they head to Nashville to take on Lipscomb on Thursday and Belmont on Friday.

* Mercer's James Florence leads the conference in scoring, in league games, averaging 22.2 points per game. If he can maintain an average of at least 20.0 PPG, he join only one other active player in the country, Davidson's Stephen Curry, to post three seasons of averaging at least 20.0 PPG in league games.

* Belmont point guard Alex Renfroe has scored in double figures in 11 straight games. A two-time Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honoree this season, Renfroe leads the conference in assists and ranks in the Top 10 in scoring, rebounding, steals and three-point field goal percentage. The Hermitage, Tenn. native set a Bruin Curb Event Center record and a NCAA single-game high for guards this season with 18 rebounds against Mercer Jan. 26.

* Feb. 16 against USC Upstate, Belmont's Andy Wicke and Matthew Dotson became the first pair of active teammates in the NCAA this season to each have over 200 career three-point field goals. Currently, Wicke has 285 and Dotson 203.

* Belmont's 54 points against Kennesaw State Feb. 20 marked the fewest points scored in a Bruin victory since Nov. 30, 2003 - a 46-38 victory over Air Force.

* The Bruins conclude regular season play this week, hosting North Florida Feb. 26 and Jacksonville Feb. 28.

* Campbell (13-15, 10-9 A-Sun) has doubled its A-Sun wins total (5-11) from a year ago. The Camels have reached double figure wins in conference regular season play for the first time since the 2000 club finished 10-8.

* The Camels sit in sixth place in the A-Sun standings heading into Friday's regular season finale, but could finish as high as fourth, depending on the outcome of this week's games.

* Kyle Vejraska tied a school Division I era (since 1977-78) record with seven blocked shots in Monday's 68-62 win over ETSU. Four of the rejections came in the last 2:02 as Campbell held ETSU to 0-of-8 shooting from the floor in the last four minutes of the game.

* Lorne Merthie scored 20 points vs. ETSU, his second 20-plus point outing in the last 3 games, to help the Camels win their third-straight contest. On the year, Merthie ranks 2nd among A-Sun freshmen in scoring (9.3) and 3-pointers made per game (1.7), while leading all league frosh in steals (1.57) and 3-point percentage (.397).

* The Buccaneers went 1-1 on the road last week in Atlantic Sun Conference play, dropping USC Upstate 66-61 on Feb. 19 before falling to Campbell 68-62 on Feb. 23. ETSU now stands at 18-10 overall, 12-6 in A-Sun play, and are hoping to finish strong with a pair of home games this weekend against Kennesaw State (7 p.m., Feb. 26) and Mercer (4 p.m., Feb. 28).

* The Bucs need to improve on their recent play, having watched their first place standing in the league earlier in the month disappear after going 3-5 over their last eight games.

* If the Bucs can pick up two more victories they would reach the 20-win plateau for the third time in head coach Murry Bartow's six seasons at ETSU.

* Senior forward Kevin Tiggs (Flint, Mich.) continues to lead the Bucs offensively with 21.2 points per game, while junior guard Mike Smith (Vandalia, Mo.) has posted double-doubles in six of his last eight contests - which included scoring a career high 25 points against Campbell.
