

**2009 General Shale Brick
Atlantic Sun Women's Basketball Championship
Allen Arena: March 6, 2009**



Game Notes: No. 1 ETSU 82, No. 4 Mercer 60

ETSU

- * The 22-point margin of victory represents the largest margin in an A-Sun Championship game for the Lady Bucs. They set their previous record, 20 points, in last year's semifinal, defeating Lipscomb 84-64
- * ETSU will play for its second-straight title. No A-Sun women's school has won back-to-back A-Sun Championships since Georgia State won in 2002 and 2003.
- * 2009 Player of the Year Siarre Evans continued her late-season charge. She registered her seventh double-double in her last eight games, 17th overall (leads A-Sun)
- * Evans surpassed the 1300-point mark. Her 20 points boosted her total to 1303, one point behind Jennifer Campbell (1977-80) for sixth on the school's scoring list.
- * Shot 54.0 FG Pct, a season best...previous high was 51.9 (27-52) at FGCU 1/8/09

MERCER

- * The Bears advanced to the semifinals for just the third time in last 15 seasons. Their only two semifinal appearances in that time span came in 2002 and 2006
- * Mercer did not miss a free throw in the game (6-for-6), the first time this season.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * ETSU will face the winner of Belmont and Jacksonville game in the 2009 General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Conference Championship game. The Lady Bucs defeated the Dolphins in last year's title game, 75-72. Belmont beat ETSU in the 2007 final, 69-57.
