Game Notes: No. 2 Jacksonville 63, No. 7 Lipscomb 51

JACKSONVILLE

- * The Dolphins opened the game on a 14-2 run, spanning the first 5:21. They hit seven of their first nine shots from the floor.
- * Junior forward Desarae Johnson climbed the career blocks list with one on Wednesday. She increased her total to 87, moving past Talia Johnson for third place on the all-time list. Next on the list sits Milica Milijkovic with 90 rejections from 1999 to 2001.
- * Johnson also moved into solo possession of third place on the single-season blocks list with 48. She entered play sharing third with Kara Donnell. Ashley Williams, 54 in 2005-06 sits in second place.
- * Jacksonville extends in win steak against Lipscomb to four in a row.
- * Regina Omoite tied the Jacksonville A-Sun Championship single-game record for assists in a game with seven.

LIPSCOMB

- * The Lady Bisons fall to 1-20 when scoring less than 60 points
- * Lipscomb is the first host to lose in its first game since Troy lost to Georgia State in 2002.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Jacksonville advances to the semifinals for the third consecutive March. The Dolphins will take on the winner of Thursday's Belmont-Campbell contest at 2:30 p.m CT
- * Jacksonville's win continues No. 2 seeds dominance of seventh seeds. The second seed has never lost in 19 contests against the seventh seed.
