Atlantic Sun Player of the Week Jeremy Gillan - Jacksonville (C - Sr. - Port St. Lucie, Fla.)

Gillan dug the long ball over the past week as the Dolphins are primed to earn the top seed in the conference tourney. In five games, the catcher hit .409 while blasting five homers. During the week, which carried over from a Sunday contest at Kennesaw State, Gillan hit a home run in four consecutive games (Kennesaw State, Florida A&M, Florida State and Bethune-Cookman) to nearly double his season total. Gillan went 3-for-4 with a double and a career-best two home runs while tallying four RBI at Florida A&M. On Sunday at Mercer, the senior went 3-for-6 with a home run and two RBI. With the five jacks, Gillan ran his season total to 11 home runs and becomes one of 18 players in the A-Sun to post double figure home run totals so far this season.

Atlantic Sun Pitcher of the Week Andy Mauldin - Stetson (RHP - Sr. - Gainesville, Fla.)

Mauldin registered Stetson's first complete game victory of the season in a 4-1 defeat of ETSU. The senior right hander fanned 11 Bucs to help the Hatters clinch a spot in next week's A-Sun Championship. At crucial moment in the third inning, with the game tied, Mauldin induced a double-play ball followed by a fly out to limit the damage to one run. After that instance, Mauldin did not allow another hit and capped the game by striking out the side in the ninth inning. The Gainesville, Fla., native majors in Marketing. Stetson swept the series with ETSU and stand in a three-way tie with Belmont and Lipscomb for the second-seed in the championship.

Atlantic Sun Series of the Week Lipscomb at ETSU Thursday-Saturday, May 14-16 Cardinal Park - Johnson City, Tenn.

The Atlantic Sun regular season concludes this weekend with only one seed for next week's A-Sun Championship determined and two spots still available among three schools. ETSU, who has missed the six-team fields each of the last two seasons, sits in the sixth position and can secure its spot with a combination of three wins or three Campbell losses. At 15-12, Lipscomb, the conference's defending champion, can enter anywhere the A-Sun Championship anywhere from the second seed to the fourth seed. The Bisons' Rex Brothers enters the weekend with 120 strikeouts, 24th on the A-Sun single-season list. He needs 10 K's to break into the top 10 and only eight to post the highest strikeout total in the conference since 2001.

* With one weekend left in the regular season, only Jacksonville has locked up its seed for the A-Sun Championship. The Dolphins secured the top seed for only the second time as a member of the conference (2006). Three schools, Belmont, Lipscomb and Stetson share second place at 15-12. Only the Bruins have a home series, taking on Mercer. Lipscomb travels across the state to face ETSU and Stetson heads south to take on FGCU.

* The Bears and Buccaneers are part of a three-time battle for the final two spots, along with Campbell. Mercer's magic number sits at two while ETSU's is three. Campbell must record one more win in its series against USC Upstate than ETSU picks up against Lipscomb to pass the Buccaneers or two more wins than Mercer to clip the Bears.

* The distinction as the regular-season champion is also up for grabs this weekend. FGCU needs one win or a Kennesaw State loss to collect its second title in as many years in the conference. UCF, from 2000 to 2002 is the last school to win back-to-back regular-season titles.

* Campbell entertains conference foe USC Upstate in what is shaping up to be a thrilling end to the season. Campbell was swept a year ago by the Spartans, but the Camels are looking to return the favor en route to a potential berth in the 2009 A-Sun Baseball Championship.

* In the 8-7 victory over Lipscomb, Campbell scored its 471st run, a new school record, passing the old record of 470 set by the 1985 squad. The Camels of 2009 are the first team in school history to post 500+ runs, as they scored 36 in the doubleheader sweep of Alabama A&M.

* Ryan Hamme enters the final weekend with a .464 batting average, tying him for the single season Campbell record as well as Atlantic Sun record. Hamme is currently 70 points ahead of the CU single season batting average for a lefty.

The Bucs are looking to make the tournament for the first time in three years.

* The Eagles sit in first place in the A-Sun and need just one win this weekend to clinch their second straight A-Sun regular season title. FGCU is currently 2.5 games ahead of Kennesaw State who plays UNF to close out the 2009 season.

* Josh Chester batted .435 last week, going 10-for-23. Chester racked up 12 RBI, hit safely in all five games, and recorded four multiple hit games, and four multiple RBI games.

* Senior Derek Shaw made two appearances last week, combining for a 1.23 ERA in 7.1 innings pitched. Shaw recorded 10 strike outs on the week, only allowing one run on four hits. Against FAU, Shaw received the win after he worked three innings, allowed only two hits, one run, struck out four to earn his fourth win of the season.

* After belting 13 more homeruns this past week, the Eagles are first in the A-Sun with 74 homeruns. Last season, the Eagles only hit 43 home runs, but currently have three hitters atop the A-Sun in home runs. Tim Roberson's 19 home runs lead the A-Sun, Zach Maxfield's 18 home runs put him in second, and Robert Greene's 14 home runs place him tied for fifth.

* In a 25-3 win over Mercer on May 10, the Dolphins tallied season highs with 23 runs and 26 hits and recorded the most hits in a game since 21 vs. Florida A&M on Feb. 5, 2002, and most runs by a JU squad since 23 vs. Florida A&M on Feb. 4, 2000. JU hit five home runs for the second consecutive game; Thomas Myers went 3-for-3 with two home runs and four RBI and became the first Dolphin to hit two homers in an inning since Phil Sottile vs. Akron on March 27, 1984. Chuck Opachich went 3-for-4 with two RBI, Dan Maier batted 3-for-6 with two doubles and an RBI, Jamaal Hawkins finished 3-for-6 with an RBI and Alex Swenson went 3-for-3 with a double and an RBI...freshman Joey Belviso also enjoyed a career day by going 2-for-3 with two home runs and four RBI.

* At Florida: Senior Garrett Dunlap (1-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing seven runs (two earned) on seven hits with a walk and a strikeout in 4.2 innings...junior Glenn Witkowski and sophomore Matt Tomshaw combined for 3.1 innings of scoreless relief...senior left fielder Kyle Fleming led the Dolphins by going 2-for-4 with a double...senior catcher Jeremy Gillan tallied a double in the first to extend his career-best hitting streak to 18 games.

He was 4-of-4 in the game and drove in seven runs. It was the first time a Bisons player had driven in seven runs in a game since Caleb Joseph accomplished the feat March 9, 2007. Dodd has previously hit only three home runs for the entire season.

* Dodd also has an active 12-game hitting streak, the second longest streak of the season for the Bisons (Justin Sanders, 13).

* Junior left-handed pitcher Rex Brothers is ranked second in the NCAA in strikeouts and is fifth in strikeouts per nine innings (12.75). He is 30th in hits allowed per nine innings with 7.01.

* Junior right-handed pitcher Josh Smith is rated 33rd in the NCAA in strikeouts and 56th in strikeouts per nine innings (9.83). He is 67th in hits allowed per nine innings (7.7).

* Senior reliever Kyle Tognazzini is tied for the team season high in saves with seven. Seth Kuwik had seven in 2005.

* Junior outfielder Tyler Wilson is ranked 32nd in stolen bases in the NCAA.

* Mercer and Belmont will meet for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times this weekend, with Belmont holding a 12-10 lead in the series. The two teams have split their last 10 meetings. The Bears took last year's series, 2-1 in Macon.

* Mercer's leading hitter, Michael Langley (.366, 6 HR, 26 RBI) carries an eight-game hitting streak into this weekend. He is one of three Bears to amass a 12-game hitting streak this season.

* Senior first baseman Steve Karwatt is sitting on 97 career RBI and hopes to reach the century mark in the weekend series. In 20-career at-bats against Belmont, Karwatt is hitting only .150 with one RBI.

* The Ospreys will be seeking their second-straight winning record in A-Sun play and third in four seasons in the league this week against Kennesaw State.

* Junior Justin Preckajlo has been red-hot over the past five games, running up a 1.083 slugging percentage and a .542 batting average. He cracked three home runs, two double and triple in the stint, scoring eight runs and driving in 10. He holds a team-second best .333 batting average this season.

* UNF is 15-13 in day games this season and 7-16 in night games.

* Senior pitcher John Frawley has a career-high seven wins this season and leads the team with the nation's 72nd-best ERA (3.22). He has also earned two A-Sun Player of the Week honors this season.

* UNF will finish the season with a losing record for just the second time (2007) in 13 seasons. The Ospreys have had only three losing seasons (1996) in their 22-season program history.

* The Ospreys will honor seven seniors in their season-ending series opener Thursday night (Frawley, Antonio Franzese, Mike Gottlieb, Spencer Jones, Ty Pryor, Phil Rorabaugh and Brian Wilson).

* Senior Phillip Morgan is on a Division I-era record 22-game hitting streak. In that time, he is hitting .436 (41-for-94) with nine doubles, three homers, 16 runs and 26 RBI. Morgan's hitting streak is the longest since Chris Nowak hit in 27 straight games in 2002.

* Eric Guillen moved past Jason Westbrook (1993-95, 179) and into 10th place in school history in career hits on Saturday, thanks to a five-hit doubleheader against UNF. He has 183 career hits.

* Guillen is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with 11 runs, four doubles, a triple and 12 RBI in the last eight games. The shortstop saw a string of six straight multiple-hit games end Sunday against UNF.

* In his last 21 games, junior Ryan Wilkins has raised his batting average from .077 to .330 by going 30-for-81 (.370) with 21 runs and 15 RBI. Wilkins is currently tied for fifth in the A-Sun with three triples.

* Keith Bisgounis is 9-for-21 with six runs and two RBI in the last six games.

* Senior Dennis McCraney has appeared in 75 career games on the mound, just one away from the school record of 76 set by Chris Fowler from 1989-92. He is currently tied with Stan Smith (2001-04) for the second-most appearances.

* Friday's win over ETSU secured a spot in the upcoming A-Sun tournament hosted by the Hatters in DeLand.

* Three Hatters are currently riding hitting streaks of 10 or more. Aaron Crittenden leads the way at 18 games in a row, while Jeremy Cruz and Jacob deGrom are each at 11 straight games.

* Stetson will Travel to FGCU this weekend to finish out the regular season. With JU in at #1, this weekend's results will determine the remaining tournament seedings.
