Game Notes: No. 8 Kennesaw State 72, No. 1 Lipscomb 69

LIPSCOMB

- * With 29 points, 2010 Player of the Year Adnan Hodzic extended his nation's leading streak of double-digit scoring to 57 games. He has topped 20 points in 12 straight games
- * Hodzic's 16 rebounds set a Lipscomb record for a single A-Sun Championship game. Brandon Brown held the record when he grabbed 10 rebounds against Campbell on March 5, 2009
- * Hodzic's 29 points set a Lipscomb record for a single A-Sun Championship game. James Poindexter held the record when he scored 24 points against Jacksonville on March 5, 2009
- * In his last 3 games, Hodzic averaged 30.0 points and 17.7 rebounds.

KENNESAW STATE

- * The Owls placed four players in double figures, led by Kurtis Woods' 19. Kelvin McConnell scored 14, Markeith Cummings scored 13 and Spencer Dixon scored 11
- * Woods and McConnell combined to hit 9-11 on their 3-point tries. The rest of the team combined to shoot just 2-16 from beyond the arc.
- * Woods hit 5 3-point fields goals for the third time this season (12/5 vs Lipscomb and 12/22 at Georgia Tech)

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Kennesaw State's win represents the first time a No. 8 seed has defeated the top seed since 2000 when Mercer defeated Troy, 79-75. No. 1 seeds now hold an 18-5 advantage on the No. 8 seeds. No. 1 seeds had won their last nine opening-round games.
- * The last No. 8 seeds to win a semifinal game was FIU in 1995. The Panthers went on to win the conference title that season.
