Game Notes: No. 4 Belmont 70, No. 5 Kennesaw State 65 (OT)

BELMONT

* Second Team All-Atlantic Sun performer Haley Nelson registered her eighth double-double of the season, collecting 16 points and 20 rebounds. In her last game against the Owls (Sat. Feb 27), Nelson totaled only 4 points and 7 rebounds.

* With 20 rebounds, Nelson recorded her fifth game with at least 15 rebounds, and her first since grabbing 15 at Lipscomb on Jan. 11

* Nelson's the A-Sun Women's Championship single-game record accomplished most recently by Gardner-Webb's Shameka Smith against Belmont on March 10, 2006.

* Kirstin Bunch scored 13 points. In three games against the Owls this season, she averaged 17.0 ppg.

KENNESAW STATE

* Thursday's game played out like many of the Owls games since February 1. In their last 10 games games, seven were decided by five points or less. The Owls fall to 5-2 in those contests.

* DeAndrea Bullock finished with 16 points one point off her season high of 17 (vs Evansville).

* With 11 rebounds, Sametria Gideon recorded her 10th game with double-digit rebounds.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

* Belmont advances to the semifinals for the fourth time in the last five seasons. In four previous trips to that round, the Bruins are only 1-3, defeating Gardner-Webb, 57-48 in 2007 as part of a run that ended with a title.

* Thursday's game marked the first overtime game in an A-Sun Women's Championship game since March 9, 2006 when Mercer beat ETSU, 59-56.

* Thursday's game featured 13 ties and 19 lead changes.
