Jacksonville Head Coach Jill Dunn:

Opening Statements

“We are extremely excited to get this win. We came in as the underdog and we didn’t like that title, but we wanted to fight. We wanted to prove that we are a better team than what our record indicated this year. We wanted to step up at the end here when it really matters.”

What stood out:

“Offensively we were playing pretty fluid the first half. I think we hit a dry spot there in the second half, but I thought our defense stayed tough the entire game.”

On shooting percentage

“We have struggled to stay hot for 40 minutes and again we got to find other ways to score when we are not hitting out shots and that is really what we are focusing on is try and get to that free-throw line or trying to score by offensive rebounds. But most importantly let our defense turn into our transition offense.

On UNF tomorrow:

“We are looking forward to it. There is only one team from Jacksonville that can be here after tomorrow and our goal is to be that team.”

GiGi Thomas:

On taking the shot clock down:

“I wasn’t trying to trying purposefully to run the clock down, but I did want to try and get people some looks especially inside the post because they couldn’t really stop us inside. When I had the ball with four seconds left to go I had to do what I know best and that is to score.”

On the last three games:

“I really have no idea what has been going on but I like it. That is the way I know how to play that is the way I am used to playing and hopefully we can keep it going the way it’s been going and win a championship.

Campbell Head Coach Wanda Watkins:

“We are very disappointed in our performance tonight. I want to congratulate Jacksonville University. I thought on a number of occasions they did what they had to do to win.”

“I thought our kids played hard, offensively we were a little out of sync as you could tell. We had a good run where we cut it to four and got hung on that for a great while. We had

a few costly turnovers, a few easy missed layups and those are the kind of things that really hurt as we were trying to catch up.”

“There were about three occasions where we got down to the shot clock and thought that we were going to get the defensive stop and then they made the play. And the opposite end we couldn’t get to that point.”
