Note Sheet: No. 6 UNF 68, No. 3 Jacksonville 64

UNF

- * UNF wins for only the 4th time when trailing at the half. The 6-point halftime deficit is the largest the Ospreys have overcome this season.
- * Tonight's game represents the eighth game in the last nine for UNF decided by single digits. The Ospreys have won four straight such contests and improve to 11-8 in games decided by less than 10 points.
- * The Ospreys win for only the second time in 14 all-time meetings with the Dolphins.
- * The Ospreys extend their win streak to four – their second-ever four-game win streak as a Division I program. They won five in row from Dec 21, 2009 through Jan. 2, 2010.
- * The Ospreys improve to 6-1 in neutral site games over the last two years. The lone loss in that span was to Jacksonville in last year's A-Sun Championship

JACKSONVILLE

- * Jacksonville saw its 11-game win streak vs UNF end. The win streak matched the program's longest vs any opponent. JU has beaten Rollins College 11 straight dating back from 1959 through 1965 (the streak remains active, but the two haven't met since 1965)
- * The Dolphins collected 8 steals and moved up to fourth on the school's single-season list with 249. Last season's team set the program record with 279 steals.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * With tonight's win, No. 6 seeds have upset the No. 3 seed in five of the last six A-Sun Championships. Stetson beat FAU in FAU, Campbell beat Jacksonville in 2007, Gardner-Webb beat Stetson in 2008 and Mercer beat Belmont in 2010. The only No. 3 seed to advance past the No. 6 seed came in 2009 when Belmont beat Mercer on a game-winning lay-up by Mick Hedgepeth with 0.2 seconds left.
- * Jacksonville fails to advance to the semifinals for the first time since 2007; They are 0-2 all-time as a No. 3 seed
