

**2011 General Shale Brick

Note Sheet: No. 6 Belmont 54, No. 3 Campbell 42

BELMONT

- * The 42 points allowed set a General Shale Brick single-game record. The previous record came in 1998 when FIU defeated Florida Atlantic, 72-43, in a quarterfinal game.
- * Belmont wins its first-round General Shale Brick game for the fifth time in the last six years.
- * Tereva Moore pulled down 12 rebounds after grabbing only six in two regular-season games this season against the Camels
- * Moore's 12 rebounds represent her third double-digit rebounding game in her last seven games and are
- * In her sixth game back after missing four of the previous five, Haley Nelson totaled xx points and x rebounds. In those six games she has averaged 14.2 points and 6.7 rebounds

CAMPBELL

- * In their two losses to Belmont (tonight and on Feb. 12), the Camels averaged only 43.5 points while shooting 32-for-117 (27.4 percent) and only 4-for-28 (14.3 percent) from the 3-point arc
- * Campbell's loss extends its losing streak in A-Sun Championship to nine straight games. The Camels last won an A-Sun Championship game on March 9, 2001 when they defeated Troy, 84-55, in a semifinal contest. They lost by two points to Georgia State in the title game one day later.
- * Campbell loses as the No. 3 seed in the first round for the second year in a row. Jacksonville beat Campbell, 52-46.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Belmont eliminates Campbell for the second time in the last three years. The Bruins beat the Camels in a 2009 quarterfinal game.
- * Belmont meets Stetson in an A-Sun semifinal. The two have met three previously with Stetson winning twice. They eliminated the Bruins in 2004 as the eighth seed; they beat Belmont in 2005 in the quarterfinals en route to winning the title. Belmont beat Stetson in 2006 in the quarterfinals as the top seed.
