

**2011 General Shale Brick
Atlantic Sun Women's Basketball Championship
University Center: March 4, 2011**



Note Sheet: No. 2 Stetson 48, No. 6 Belmont 46

STETSON

- * The Hatters advance to their third-ever title game (1989 and 2005). In General Shale Brick Women's Championship play, the Hatters had not won a game since that 2005 title game prior to the two this year.
- * The Hatters earned their 19th win, their most since winning 22 in 2000-01.
- * After averaging only 8.3 points per game in her last 3 games, Victoria McGowan scored 22 points, including the game-winning 50 footer.
- * The 19 wins are the second-most in the coaching career of Lynn Bria. She can tie for career high with a win in the title game. She led UCF to the 1999 A-Sun Championship, leading the Golden Knights to a 20-10 season.
- * Tierra Brown played in her 117th career game, tying Kim Manning for second in program history. She will tie Janene Maclin for the program record by appearing in tomorrow's final.

BELMONT

- * The Bruins held both opponents at the A-Sun Championship under 50 points (Campbell scored 42 on Thursday). They became just the 3rd team to hold two teams under 50 points at the same A-Sun Championship (FIU in 1998 and UNF in 2010).
- * Over her final four games of the season, Haley Nelson averaged 17.5 points per game.
- * In her seventh game back after missing four of the previous five, Haley Nelson totaled 18 points and 11 rebounds. In those seven games she has averaged 14.7 points and 7.3 rebounds.
- * Shaunda Strayhorn scored 7 points; she falls one point shy of recording 1,000 for her career.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Stetson will attempt to win the seventh title by the No. 2 seed in A-Sun Championship history. After winning four out of seven between 2006 and 2006, the No. 2 seed has not won one since.
- * Stetson improves to 3-1 against Belmont in A-Sun Championship play – its most wins at the Championship against any of the current A-Sun members.
