JACKSONVILLE:

Head Coach Lynn Bria - *Opening Statement*

"Wow. It was a great game. I thought the whole game was good. I thought Belmont did a really good job defensively on us. We had a hard time getting anything going. It definitely wasn't an offensive barnbuster, it was a defensive game for both teams. It was just an unbelievable shot that Victoria made. I guess if there is time on the clock you always have a chance."

On the foul at the end of the game to set up the shot and not having timeouts.

"It was probably a blessing that I didn't have timeouts because we could get it on the right like that and go...We were very fortunate to win this game. I really thought - if nothing else - that it would go to overtime I just did not want to give them a three-point play, which we did. But that's the beauty of the game, the real highs and lows."

On the last second shot.

"I was just trying to get a shot off before the clock ran out and I didn't think I would have enough time, but I did and I prayed for that to go in...I have never did it in a game. It felt good and I saw the rotation was good so I thought it had a chance, but I wasn't sure."

BELMONT:

Head Coach Brittney Ezell - *Opening statement*

"It's not exactly the way you want to make a highlight reel. I was so proud of our kids' effort. I think the past two nights we have been, by far the best defensive team here. I think that the way we compete on the defensive end and on the boards was remarkable. I am so honored to be this team's head coach and be the head coach at Belmont. It is an emotional roller coaster when you play games like this, but somebody has to win and somebody has to lose. Give her a lot of credit for hitting the last second shot.
