

**2011 General Shale Brick
Atlantic Sun Women's Basketball Championship
University Center: March 5, 2011**



Note Sheet: No. 2 Stetson 69, No. 5 Jacksonville 50

STETSON

- * Freshman Sasha Sims shot 6-for-7 from the 3-point arc – one shy of the tournament's single game record. Three players had made 7, most recently Marica Maddox for Georgia State vs Stetson in 2002.
- * Sims had made only six 3-pointers in her last six games. Her 24 points established a career high. Her previous best came against Jacksonville State when she scored 19 points.
- * Victoria McGowan – Tournament MVP – averaged 14.7 points, 4.3 rebounds in three games.
- * The Hatters earned their 20th win, their most since winning 22 in 2000-01.
- * Tierra Brown played in her 118th career game, tying Janene Maclin for the program record.

JACKSONVILLE

- * Taneskei Richardson: 11 rebounds – her 17th game this season with double-digits rebounds. She finished with 315 ranking 17th in A-Sun on the A-Sun's single-season chart.
- * In the two General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Championship games prior to the final, the Dolphins had held their two opponents (UNF and ETSU) to a combined 2-for-21 from the arc. Stetson connected on 9-of-16 (56.3 percent) – second-best shooting performance by a JU opponent this season – FGCU shot 11-for-19 on Dec. 4 (57.9 percent).
- * Jacksonville falls to 0-3 all-time in title games. They are the only school to appear in at least 3 finals and not win once.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Stetson's 19-point win is the largest in the title game since the Hatters defeated Georgia State, 88-62 in the 2005 title game.
- * Stetson becomes the third A-Sun program to win three General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Championships. The Hatters join FIU (6 titles), ETSU (3 titles), Georgia Southern (3 titles) and Georgia State (3 titles).
- * Head coach Lynn Bria becomes the first coach in the Atlantic Sun to win conference tournaments at multiple schools. She led UCF to the 1999 A-Sun Championship, leading the Golden Knights to a 20-10 season.
