**STETSON**

- \* 18<sup>th</sup> win – up from 6 in 2009-10 – represents second-best turnaround in the nation (McNeese State won 7 games in 2009-10, has 21 so far)
- \* Tierra Brown scored 25 points on 10-of-14 shooting. In three games vs Kennesaw State this season, she averaged 21.3 points per game and shot 56.5 percent (26-for-46)
- \* Brown's 25 points established a career high – her previous high, 23, came against Belmont on Jan 4., 2010
- \* Brown surpassed Sarah Foley for on the Hatters' all-time scoring list. She now has scored 1,206 points; Foley totaled 1,200 in her career.
- \* Improves to 10-3 all-time against Kennesaw State and have won the last five

**KENNESAW STATE**

- \* Shot only 16-for-61 from the floor. In three games against Stetson, shot only 30.6 percent and averaged only 53.0 points in the three games (lost all 3).
- \* Sametria Gideon totaled 13 points and eight rebounds. In three contests against Stetson, she averaged 15.3 points and 13.0 rebounds.
- \* Falls to 1-14 away from home

**A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES**

- \* Advanced to the General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Women's Championship semifinal round for the first time since winning the tournament in 2005.
- \* No. 2 seeds improve to 20-1 against No. 7 seeds in A-Sun Championship play. The lone No. 7 victory came last season when UNF defeated Mercer
