JACKSONVILLE

- * For the second consecutive General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Women's Championship, the Dolphins open by upsetting a higher seed. One year ago, they beat No. 3 Campbell.
- * The Dolphins end a 4-game losing streak to the Ospreys. Prior to today, their last win in the series came on Jan. 18, 2010. They own a 9-5 lead in the all-time series
- * With five rebounds, Taneskei Richardson increased her season total to 298. She needs two to become the first in JU history and the 25th in A-Sun history to reach the 300-rebound mark.
- * The Dolphins improve to 6-9 in games decided by less than 10 points. Jacksonville had lost five of its last six decided by single digits.
- * Jessica George scored a career-high 17 points. Twice she had totaled 15, most recently on Dec. 2, 2010 against Stetson.

UNF

- * With 12 points, Brittany Kirkland points, Brittany Kirkland reached the 1,200-point barrier, becoming only the third in school history to reach that plateau.
- * With four assists, Juliemay Syquio passed Skye Barber to become the school's all-time leader. Barber totaled 404 while at UNF. Syquio finishes with 408 assists.
- * Atlantic Sun Defensive Player of the Year Larkira Jones totaled only six rebounds and failed to block a shot. The six rebounds are her fewest since grabbing five against Belmont on Jan. 18.
- * After opening the game 2-for-18, the Ospreys shot 17-for-36 the remainder of the contest.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Jacksonville advances to play ETSU at noon on Friday in semifinal action. ETSU eliminated Jacksonville in the 2007, 2008 and 2009 tournaments. In 2008 and 2009, the Buccaneers beat the Dolphins in the title game
- * ETSU and Jacksonville have advanced to the semifinals each the last five years – tied for the longest active streak in the conference
